



Let's make Adoption Posters!

Purpose: To promote adoptable pets at your local Animal shelter/rescue. Shelters and rescues love to share adoption posters on their social media. Consider displaying the posters on a hallway bulletin board at your school or at your local library too!

Materials List:

1) Poster Board or Cardboard

You can re-purpose a piece of cardboard from a box or use a poster board. Make it large enough so it's easily readable.

2) Construction paper – various colors

3) Scissors, Markers and Glue(stick)

4) Pictures and descriptions of the adoptable pets!

Go to your local animal shelter/rescue's website and select the pets up for adoption you'd like to make poster(s) for. You can either print out pictures or draw your own picture or use both! *Optional: magazines*

Instructions:

- 1) Gather your supplies from the list above.
- 2) Get your adoptable pet pictures/drawings ready along with any other fun cut-outs like dog bones, hearts, etc.
- 3) Plan and Design your poster before you glue anything down. Include:
 - Name of the Shelter/Rescue & Logo
 - Name of the adoptable pet
 - Picture of the adoptable pet (photocopy and/or drawn)
 - Description of the pet (print out from shelter/rescue website or re-write it your own fun way!)
 - How to contact the shelter/website to meet the pet (website link/phone number)
- 4) When ready, glue it altogether and have fun making your poster!
- 5) Take pictures of your poster(s) and email them to your shelter/rescue. Also, see where you can display your poster: hallway school bulletin board so your entire school/staff can see them, local library or even in your neighborhood!



Approximate time to make one poster after you have materials ready: 30 – 60 min
